

天津市高职院校春季招收中职毕业生考试 英语科目考试大纲 (2016 年 9 月修订)

一、考试性质与目标

天津市高职院校春季考试招生是普通高等学校招生的重要组成部分，是推进我市高职院校分类考试招生改革的重要举措。高职院校通过春季考试招收中职毕业生实行“文化基础+职业技能”的评价方式。

英语学科考试旨在考查考生在语言知识、语言技能、情感态度、学习策略和文化意识等素养整合发展基础上的综合语言运用能力，特别是用英语获取信息、处理信息、分析和解决问题的能力以及跨文化交际能力。

二、考试内容与能力要求

依据中华人民共和国教育部 2009 年颁布的《中等职业学校英语教学大纲》以及高等职业院校对新生文化素质的要求，制定英语学科的考查内容与能力要求。

一、语言知识

1. 掌握并能运用英语语音、语法基础知识以及所学功能意念和话题（见附录）；
2. 词汇要求：掌握 1800 左右单词及 300 左右习惯用语和固定搭配。单词条目参见所附词汇表。

二、语言运用

1. 阅读

要求考生能读懂书、报、杂志中关于一般性话题的简短语篇以及请柬、通知、公告、广告等，并能从中获取相关信息，完成不同的阅读任务。具体包括：

- (1) 理解、捕捉文中具体信息；
- (2) 根据上下文识别指代关系；
- (3) 根据上下文推断生词的词义；
- (4) 根据所读内容作出简单的推理和判断；
- (5) 理解所读内容的主旨；
- (6) 理解作者的意图、基本观点和态度。

2. 写作

要求考生根据题目要求完成简单的书面表达任务。

三、考试方式与试卷结构

(一) 考试方式

考试为闭卷、笔试，试卷满分为 150 分，考试限定用时为 60 分钟。

(二) 试卷结构

试卷分为第 I 和第 II 两卷。第 I 卷包含单项填空、完形填空、阅读理解和补全对话等部分，为

客观性试题。第 II 卷包含阅读回答问题（或英译汉）部分，为主观性试题。

注：第 V 部分（阅读回答问题、英译汉）为替换题型，每年度试卷将只选其中一种题型。

（三）题型说明

1. 单项填空

该部分为单项选择题；每题在一或两句话中留出空白，要求考生根据特定的语境、语法和词汇知识选出一项可填入句中空白处的最佳选项。

2. 完形填空

该部分为单项选择题；为考生提供一篇 200 词左右的英语短文，文中留出 10 个空白，文后为每个空白处留有四个可供选择的词或词组，要求考生在通读全文、领会大意的基础上，从备选词或词组中选出一个最佳选项，将短文内容补充完整。补全后的短文应用词准确、语意连贯、结构完整。

3. 阅读理解

该部分为单项选择题；试卷呈现 A、B、C 三篇短文，每篇文长在 200—250 词左右。短文后设 5 个问题，每个问题有四个备选答案，要求考生根据短文内容，选出一个正确答案。

4. 补全对话

该部分为集库式选择题。可有两种考查形式。每年度试卷只选一种。

形式一：向考生提供一段不完整的对话，对话中留出 5 个空白，要求考生根据交际情境和相关交际原则，从备选的 7 个选项中选出 5 个最恰当、得体的句子，将对话补充完整。

形式二：向考生提供五段简短对话，每段对话中留出 1 个空白，要求考生根据每段对话的交际情境和相关交际原则，从备选的 7 个选项中选出 5 个最佳选项，将每段对话补充完整。

5. 阅读回答问题

该部分为主观性试题；为考生提供一篇 200 词左右的短文，文后设 5 个问题，要求考生在阅读理解短文内容的基础上，按照题目要求用英语回答问题，完成任务。

6. 英译汉

该部分为主观性试题；为考生提供一篇 200 词左右的短文，要求考生在阅读理解文章内容的基础上将文内 5 处画线的短语或句子翻译成通顺的汉语。
